Rs. 48.55 lacs and the process of the manufacturing system is rotary kiln technology.

Following measures are proposed to minimise the dust pollution during some precautionary measures using bag filter; there will be stack with stack monitoring facility. Continuous particulate measurement analyser will be on line.

About 33% land of the proposed unit will be used for green belt area. Used and spent oil will be sold to authorised recyclers and discarded drums & bags will be returned to raw material supplier or sold to authorised recyclers.

For development of nearest three villages 5% of total expenditure will be spent, like proposed to make park & school etc.


