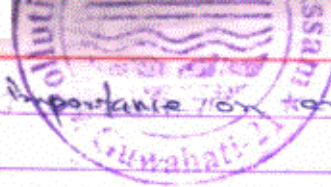

Considering the various views of public present in the Public Hearing and also the technological, environmental & ecological aspects it is resolved that M/S Guwahati Waste Management Company Private Ltd (GWM CPL), a subsidiary organisation of Guwahati Municipal Corporation (GMC), may be allowed for proposed Integrated Municipal Solid Waste Management Project at Boragaon site, Guwahati, Kamrup District, Assam subject to maintaining the total environmental quality of the area. M/S Guwahati Waste Management Company Private Limited (GWM CPL) and Guwahati Municipal Corporation (GMC) must comply with all the provisions of the Municipal Solid Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules 2000 during the construction, commissioning and operation of the proposed project. M/S Guwahati Waste Management Company Private Ltd (GWM CPL) and Guwahati Municipal Corporation (GMC) must comply with all the directions, guidelines and regulations to be issued by the Pollution Control Board, Assam, Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt of India, New-Delhi



and shall also comply with all the directions to be issued by the district administrations from time to time.
