Minutes of the Pre-Bid Meeting held at the office of Pollution Control Board of Assam, Bamunimaidam, Guwahati-21 on 23rd March'2021 at 11:30 AM via Video Conference for the Project "Establishment of A "Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage And Disposal Facility (Hwtsdf)" At Amguri, Sivasagar District, Assam"

The Member Secretary presided over the meeting and after welcoming all the Officers and the members present in the Pre-Bid meeting, requested to start the Pre-bid meeting.

Accordingly, the representative from Ramky initiated the process through Video conferencing seeking clarifications on various points based on the RFP and they were followed by BEIL Infrastructure Ltd. After detailed deliberations on those queries with the bidders, most of the queries were clarified on the spot and is enclosed herewith as the "Response to Bid Query on RFP for Selection of a Private Party to Establish a Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Discharge facility in Assam under the PPP Mode". Further, took the following resolutions:

- 1. The bidders shall be provided with the draft contract agreement and within 2 days from receiving of the draft contract agreement, the PCBA may clarify further if the bidders have further query.
- 2. The GPS location of the site shall be provided to the bidders on the basis, the bidders may design the layouts, etc.

- 3. The geo-technical investigations, soil survey, etc. have to be done by the selected bidder at their own cost during the DPR preparation stage.
- 4. The data for Quantity of Hazardous Waste Generated in Assam per Annum published under the public forum for the year of 2019-20 shall be provided to the bidders by the PCBA and the provided data will be the baseline of the total hazardous waste generated.
- 5. The area of land allotted for the HWTSDF may further be increased in discussion with Govt, of Assam in the near future.
- 6. The various Incentives & Subsidies available for industries in Assam regulated under Assam Industrial Policy'2019 and the North East Industrial Development Scheme of the DIPP, the same may be gathered by the bidders of their own. However, PCBA shall facilitate the selected bidder in availing any such incentives under those policies as mentioned above or any other under the MOEF&CC, etc., if any under their existing eligibility criteria.
- 7. The Annual report which is under the public forum for the year 2020-21 against availability statistics of HW generation in Assam, the same will be provided to the bidders immediately. However, it was clarified that PCBA cannot vouch for quantity to be available in future since the quantum of HW generators may also change .However, PCBA strongly feels that the quantity to be available in the future would not decrease from the present level but chances are there that the same may increase above 10% each year. It was suggested that the bidders, at this stage, may conceptualise an optimum installed plant capacity.

Having no other business to transact, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
