The Chairman welcomed all officials and representatives of intending tenderers and requested the representatives of tenderers to furnish their queries if any.

Mr. Dilip Kalita, one of the intending tenderers requested the Engineer in-charge (Head of Civil Engineering wing of the Board) to clarify the following queries.

1. Whether any other tenderer has submitted any pre-bid queries?
2. Whether Mobilization Advance shall be provided, if yes, upto what percentage of Tender Value.
3. Is there any restriction on Rates to be Quoted?

Er. G. Bhuyan, Head of Civil Engineering wing of the Board clarified the above queries as under-

1. No pre-bid query has been received from any other intending tenderer.
2. There is no provision of mobilization advance in the tender document. Of course, as per Clause No.72 of the Tender document Secured Advance to the extent of 75% of the value of materials shall be granted.
3. As per Clause No.62 of the tender document (Techno-Commercial Bid) abnormal Rates i.e. unusually high or unusually low rates will be sufficient cause for rejection of the Tender unless the Owner is convinced about the reasonableness of the rates quoted.

Mr. D. Kalita expressed satisfaction and thaks for clarification of his queries.
